The Squamish Lil'wat Cultural Centre (SLCC) is the first centre of its kind in Canada. **Two Nations came together to celebrate and share their cultures with the world** while creating meaningful employment opportunities for members of both the Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw (Squamish Nation, Coast Salish) and Lil'wat7ul (Lil'wat Nation, Interior Salish). Designed to evoke the form of a Squamish Longhouse and Lil'wat Istken (earthen dwelling), the SLCC stunningly embodies the spirit of partnership between two unique Nations who wish to preserve, foster, and share their traditional cultures.



TOURS

Knowledgeable Cultural Ambassadors from the Squamish and Lil'wat Nations share their cultural teachings with guests during the hourly guided tour. Offered on the hour, every hour, 10am – 4pm daily, the guided tour experience includes:

- A traditional welcome song
- Fifteen minute film
- Exhibit tour
- Cedar-rope bracelet making activity
